### **ARTICLE X**

### BYLAWS AMMEND

These Bylaws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of and voting, providing that:

- A. There is a quorum present.
- B. All proposals to amend the Bylaws are submitted in special, or emergency meeting of the Committee. originate at least four (4) calendar weeks prior to the committee or the committee.
- C. Written notice of the intention to amend these Byla of the Committee ten (10) business days prior to the meeting when voting is to take place.
- D. The notice of intention to vote upon amendments: sections, or sub-sections to be voted upon. Specifical terations must be included in the notice of intent
- E. Any amendments must also be approved by the SC
