Recommendation: **Approve Resolution #2736: To Determine Criteria for Deviation from Terminating a Certificated Employee in Order of Seniority (“Skipping Criteria”)**

Background/Rationale: With the approval of Resolution #2735: Intention to Terminate Certificated Employees Due to a Reduction of Particular Kinds of Service, criteria to determine the order of termination of certificated employees must be determined. The order of termination is based upon the needs of the District and the students. The District has determined a specific need for personnel to teach the courses or courses of study listed in Resolution 2736 and will skip employees serving in those positions consistent with Resolution #2735 and Education Code section 44955.

For the 2013-14 school year only, to meet the requirements of Education Code section 44955 subdivision (d), the Board of Education determines the needs of the District and the students by establishing the skipping criteria attached as Exhibit A.

RESOLUTION NO. 2736

RESOLUTION TO DETERMINE CRITERIA FOR DEVIATION FROM
TERMINATING A CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE IN ORDER OF SENIORITY

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Pursuant to the provisions of Education Code section 44955 subdivision (d), the District may deviate from the provisions of Education Code section 44955 subdivision (1) a specific need for personnel to teach a specific course or course of study, (2) if a certified employee has special training and experience necessary to teach that course or course of study, which others with more seniority do not possess, and (3) for purposes of maintaining or achieving compliance with constitutional requirements related to equal protection of the laws.

For the 2013-2014 school year only, to meet the requirements of Education Code section 44955, the Board of Education determines the needs of the District and the students by establishing the criteria attached as Exhibit A.
