










Middle Tier Schools = Presumptive Renewal



Renewal criteria is tied to <u>each</u> performance category/tier. MIDDLF TIER:

Consider performance schoolwide and for all subgroups on state indicators, <u>plus</u> performance on local indicators (all reflected on Dashboard)

Greater weight given to perform ance on <u>academic</u> measurements

Consider verified data (if presented by charter school) showing:

Measurable increases in academic achievement (1 year of progress); OR

Strong postsecondary outcomes

Renewal term = 5 years



Third Party Investigation of Concerns (Re:SHPS)

Why a 3rd party investigation?

- Extensive allegations against charter school organization (SHPS) brought by parents and former charter educators
- Authorizer has a legal duty to oversee charter school and monitor fiscal condition
 - Protect student interests
 - Avoid liability
- Third party review separate from standard oversight/renewal evaluation
- Why now?


Process and Considerations:

- Request for inform ation /records + review of publicly-available information
 - Linked directly to allegations
 - Objective data to validate or disprove allegations
 - o Maintained in normal course of business
- Third party review
 - Records review/site visit/interviews (as needed)
 - Prepare report of findings
- District evaluation
 - If necessary, issue notice to cure/correct
 - o 30+ days for charter school to respond with corrective action plan

- Late June: Petition Submission
- Early/Mid July: Conclude Investigation
 By July 26: <u>If necessary based on</u> <u>reported findings</u>, Board issues notice to cure and correct
 - o What would this look like?
